Following a visit to Neutrog Australia in 2008 Niall decided to set-up Neutrog Fertilisers Ireland, a licensed manufacturing and marketing company for Neutrog products in Ireland and Northern Ireland. The manufacturing facility is located in Clones Co. Monaghan, from where the company sources its staff and raw materials locally.

Neutrog supplies its products to some of the most magnificent grounds and gardens around the world including Ardgillan House in Dublin and Castlemartyr in County Cork. Neutrog products are also utilised by many of the leading commercial primary producers within the agriculture, horticulture and amenity markets.
